


# How To Find Virtual Workstation Password






Each virtual workstation that is created in the Eclipse Tech portal has an encrypted, auto-generated password that you can access.

**NOTE:** The user name used in your virtual workstation is always “Administrator”.

## Steps:

1. Login or sign-up for your account at: <https://portal.eclipsetech.co>
2. This will take you to the “**Dashboard**” of your account.
3. Make sure the virtual workstation that you want is running. The password can only be displayed while the virtual workstation is running.
4. Once the virtual workstation is in the “**running**” state, click the “**Password**” icon (the key icon).

5. This will cause the encrypted, auto-generated password to be displayed. Eclipse Tech recommends copying the password by clicking the provided copy icon.
